The Optional Application Services (OAS) Card v.1.00 for the OfficeServ™ 7200 and 7400 is Now Available!

Samsung is pleased to announce the general availability of the Optional Application Services (OAS) card. The OAS card enhances the OfficeServ 7200 and 7400 product lines by providing the resources used by the Executive MOBEX feature.

New OAS Card

The OAS Card is a 64-DSP Resource Card, meaning that it can provide up to 64 resource channels that can be used by the OfficeServ 7200 and 7400 systems. These 64 channels are used to provide DTMF listeners during Executive MOBEX calls. These DTMF listeners allow the OfficeServ system to properly respond to digits dialed by the user to initiate system features. In addition to the OAS card, the Executive MOBEX feature also requires a valid system license. See the [V4.30i Release Bulletin] for more details on Executive MOBEX feature.

*Although the OAS card provides 64 DSP resources onboard, the OfficeServ 7200 does not support 64 channel card slots, so the OAS card is limited to 32 DSPs per card in the OfficeServ 7200 system. The OAS card can only be installed in slots 3, 4 or 5 of the 7200 main cabinet.

OAS Card General Availability

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

- **OfficeServ 7400:** The OAS card requires the OfficeServ 7400 to be running V4.30i or higher system software. The OAS card requires a 64-channel universal slot in the OfficeServ 7400. This means that the card must be installed in the main cabinet to gain full functionality. If installed in an expansion cabinet the OAS card will be limited to 32 channels, or 32 DSP resources.
- **OfficeServ 7200:** The OAS card requires the OfficeServ 7200 to be running V4.30i or higher system software and an MP20 processor card. The MCP processor card does not support the OAS card or the Executive MOBEX feature. The OAS card requires a 32-channel universal slot in the OfficeServ 7200. This means that the card must be installed in the main cabinet slots 3, 4, or 5. It cannot reside in an expansion cabinet.
- **OfficeServ 7100:** The OAS card cannot be installed in the OfficeServ 7100 system.
