




Using Toll Restriction on the SVMi



This document covers the process of using the SVMi **Toll Restriction** feature to block long distance calls through the SVMi product.


1. From the **Day Main Menu** highlight **Open Block Table** and then press the <enter> key.



2. After pressing the <enter> key the **Open Block** screen will be displayed.




3. Using the up and down arrow keys highlight the **Eclass Block** and then press the <enter> key. Choose the **EClass Group** number and then press the <enter> key again.



4. Using the up and down arrow keys highlight the **Standard Block** and then press the <enter> key.



5. After pressing the <enter> key page 1 of the **Standard EClass Block** will be displayed.



6. Press **Ctrl+D** three times or until page 4 of **Standard Eclass** is displayed.

7. Make sure that the following field are set in this manner:

On Premise = Y

Off Premise = Y

Long Distance= N

Note: This allows extension and local dialing and prohibits long distance calling.

8. In the **Excepted Area Codes** field enter any long distance area code that you wish to exempt from the long distance restrictions.

5. Press **Ctrl+E** to escape and save. This completes all necessary programming for this application.
