MAC Addresses

In order to activate the Samsung OfficeServ Sofphone, E-mail Gateway Unlimited License or other OfficeServ Application, a license is required. When applying for a license the MAC Address of the associated LAN connector must be listed on the License Request Form.

a) MAC Address Information on the iDCS Product Line

The MAC Address can be obtained from MMC 830 in the iDCS 100 or iDCS 500 Release 2 v2.44 or higher or by viewing the white “LAN” sticker on the MCP2, or SMCP1.

The “LAN” sticker may appear in a number of places on the front or back of the cards. It is listed as [LAN 000000000000]. The 12 digit MAC address appears as a combination of alpha and numeric characters (0~9 and/or A-F).

b) MAC Address Information on the SVMi Product Line

Only an SVMi card with a LAN connection (Ethernet port) will have a MAC Address. Currently this applies to the SVMi-8E and SVMi-16E.

The MAC address can be obtained by logging on to the SVMi, going to the System Wide Parameters screen, Page 1, field titled MAC Address or by viewing the LAN sticker applied to the SVMi card.

The “LAN” sticker may appear in a number of places on the front or back of the card. It is listed as [LAN 000000000000]. The 12 digit MAC address appears as a combination of alpha and numeric characters (0~9 and/or A-F).
