TITLE: Falcon and Key Programming

It is important to realize that when programming the keys on Falcon keysets it is possible to program over the default transfer key. If a keyset does not have a transfer key defined you will not be able to perform keyset programming with it because "transfer" is required for keyset programming. The problem will be exacerbated if transfer keys are "overwritten" on a system wide basis using System Key Programming (MMC 723). Obviously this will mean that keyset programming via a Falcon keyset will not be possible system wide and there will not be a way to recover from the situation using a Falcon keyset. There are, however, two ways to get out of this jam. One is to make programming changes via a PC utilizing PCMMC and the other way is to enter keyset programming via a DCS (non - Falcon) Keyset.
