

Ubigate™ iES4000 Ethernet Switches Certification Course

Course Content

The Ubigate iES4000 Series Data Switches online certification course (course #: 4010-01-OL) is comprised of one module and a test. Practical questions are included in all lessons. The approximate time to complete the course module is 2 hours and the course test is 1 hour.

Course Requirements and Certification

This certification course only covers basic switch configuration and <u>requires</u> that you are familiar with basic networking functions and terminology. Knowledge for more complex switch configurations that require many steps for proper operation can be obtained by referring to the Management Guide.

In order to receive certification and technical support on the Ubigate iES4000 Series Ethernet Switches, you must complete the course module and successfully pass the test. Please allow 2 business days after completing the course for the training and technical support databases to get synchronized.
